4. _____ **Proof of high school graduation** High school graduation is documented with a final/official high school transcript which identifies the school, student, date of graduation and has an administrative signature OR administrative stamp that the registrar interprets as official. Parchment and other digital transcript services are also considered official without a signature or administrative stamp. **General Education Diploma or a State Department of Education approved high school equivalency test** (Article V, Section 2.B.1). Home school students refer to Article V, Section B.2. **Foreign transcripts must be translated to English, interpreted, approved by the college's registrar and equivalent to a U.S. high school diploma.**

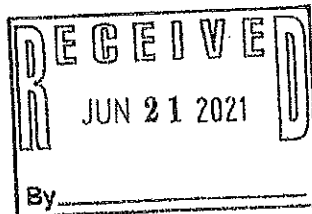

Accreditation

The university is accredited by the New England Commission of Higher Education (NECHE). The university's name was officially changed from "University" in September 1988.

Calendar

Students enrolled during or after August 2020 (MBA or M.S. programs during or after August 2018) had credit hours converted from quarter to semester. A comment will appear on the front of the transcript if this conversion has taken place. Prior to this time, all undergraduate and graduate programs operated on a term calendar awarding credit on a quarter-credit basis, with the exception of doctoral and physician assistant studies programs which have always been delivered as semester credit.

The term calendar divided the year into three, 11-week sessions in the fall, winter and spring. The semester calendar divides the year into fall and spring sessions, each spanning approximately 16 weeks of instruction. Summer sessions may also be available to students and may vary in length.

Grade Point Average (GPA)

GPA is determined by dividing the total number of grade quality points earned (multiply quality points by number of credit hours) by the total number of credit hours attempted. Only coursework completed is used when calculating GPA.

Repeat of Courses

In the case of a repeated course in which the student originally received a grade of "WF" or "F," only the passing grade ("D" or higher) received is used in the computation of the student's GPA & credits earned. The "WF" or "F" remain on the transcript, but are excluded in GPA calculation.

Prior to spring 2004: In the case of a repeated course in which the student originally received a passing grade, both grades received are used in the computation of the student's GPA and credits earned.

After spring 2004: In the case of a repeated course in which the student originally received a passing grade, only the highest grade earned is used in the computation of the student's GPA and credits earned. An indicator of "I" (include) or "E" (exclude) will follow each grade clarifying which grade is being used in the GPA calculation. When a student has repeated a course previously applied to an awarded degree, both grades are included in the GPA calculation.

Honors (H) Option

If a course was taken as an Honors Program requirement, the grade received will be followed by "H" (for example, AH, BH).

Attempted Coursework & Transfer Credit

All attempted coursework appears on the transcript. Both graduate, grade of B (3.0) or better, and undergraduate, grade of C (3.0) or better, coursework completed at institutions recognized by a U.S. Department of Education accrediting agency or at foreign institutions chartered and authorized by their national governments (usually through a ministry of education) are eligible for transfer credit; however, transfer credit is not guaranteed. In order to be eligible for transfer credit, courses must be similar in level, content and duration to courses in the student's intended program of study.

Transfer credits are not calculated into the cumulative grade point average.

Re-admittance

Academic eligibility to re-enroll is based upon probation and dismissal policies of the student's respective college (visit catalog).

Withdrawal (W), Withdrawal/Pass (WP), Withdrawal/Fail (WF)

Effective June 2017, only a grade of W is used to record withdrawal. This grade is not entered into the term and cumulative grade point averages. Prior to this, grades of W, WP, or WF were used to record withdrawal. A W was a punitive and failing grade issued at the instructor's discretion; and was entered permanently into the term and cumulative grade point averages. A WP indicated the student had an estimated grade of 60 (for undergraduate courses) or 70 (for graduate courses) or higher at the time of withdrawal. This grade was not entered into the term and cumulative grade point averages. If the estimated grade was below 60 (for undergraduate courses) or 70 (for graduate courses), the student was issued a WF, which was entered into the term and cumulative grade point averages as a failing grade until successful completion of the course at a later date.

No Credit (NC)

A non-punitive designation issued to a student who has been authorized to withdraw from class or the university due to extenuating circumstances.

Pass (P)

In courses taken on a pass/fail basis, a pass letter grade is issued when a student has achieved the equivalent to a 60% or higher (standard letter grade of D). This grade is not calculated into the semester and cumulative grade point average.

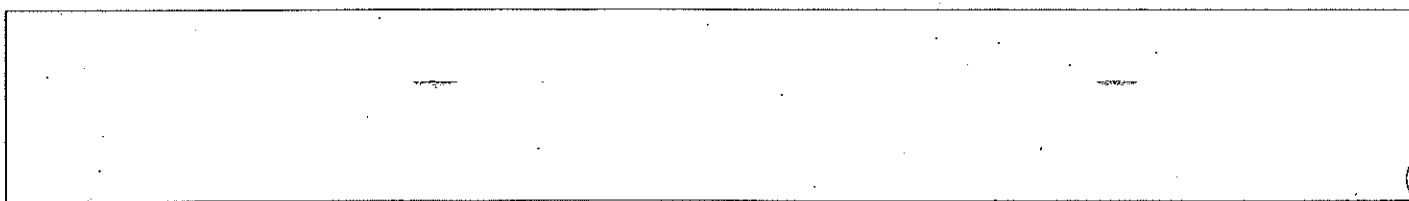

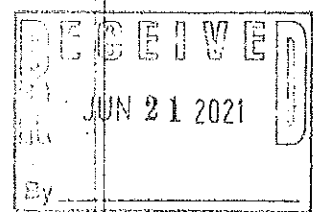

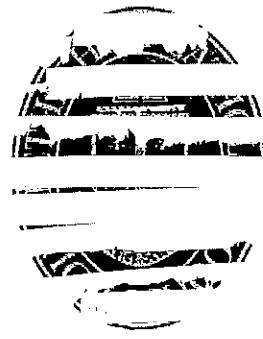
